Wilderness School in 1987 and Walford in 1989.

Old Scholars races are held in November at a special regatta conducted by the Adelaide Rowing Club under the direction of the Heads of schools.

The Clinker IV event was constituted the Second Crews' Race in 1938, and was rowed in eights from 1957.
